Tech Talk

Gene Egert brought the members up to date on the engine rebuilding efforts. We have had several engines donated by members that were in need of rebuilding or for cannibalization. So far we've rebuilt two engines from the combined parts acquired. The costs for replacement parts to date has totaled \$700.00

Seven members have been directly involved in the effort. So far we have one engine for sale. Ray McMahon has asked to buy the rebuilt engine for costs and the donation of another rebuildable engine to the club.

The parts out of each engine include the blocks, shafts, valves, piston, etc. Some parts are still in spec and can be reused with proper honing or grinding. Out of four engines we disassembled, we have assembled two engines. The proceeds from the sale of the engines will go into the Naper A's treasury. The price we're asking is far below the prices of buying one from professional builders.

The completed engine was started after two days of trying. It was tight and the 6v starter didn't have the power to turn it over. The guys used a 12v battery (by passing the ignition system) to crank it over and get it started. After running for about 20 minutes it was easier to start.

Nick Mazzarella asked for advice on completing the ends of the roof welt on his '31 stand. It turns out that there are special metal welting tips available for that purpose.
