Securing Running Board Bolts

INSTALLING RUNNING BOARDS? This tip will help hold the mounting bolts in place:


- Cut ½" lengths of ¾" inside diameter neoprene or rubber tubing.
 - Press a piece of tubing on head of running board bolt.
 - Place in each large hole of running board cross braces.
 - Press down on bolt. Using a small screwdriver,
 work bolt and tubing gently into square slot.

The bolt will stay in place while getting all bolts to go into bracket holes and will make it easier to start the nuts on the bolts.
