\$5.00 for the monthly bank charge.

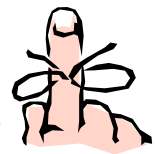
SECRETARY'S REPORT:

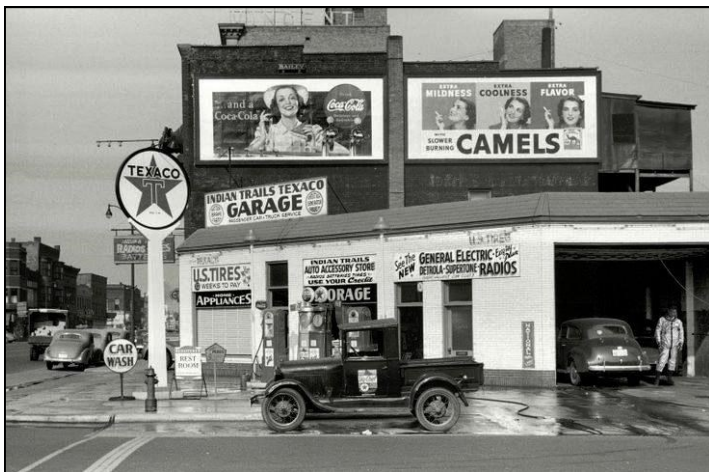
John Emmering has put together a complete OE tool kit for is '31 Roadster. He built a wood tool box to make it authentic.
